COMPETITION RULES.

1. The following rules apply only to those competitors contributing points to the Stewart Thompson Club Champion Trophy, The Mount Morgan Railway Glider Trophy and the Club's annual trophy for powered aircraft events.
2. Except for allocation of points toward the above annual trophies; these rules do not apply to the Club's Easter Scale Event.
3. There will be no minimum number of competitions for gliders or powered aircraft for the Club trophies for the year.
4. There must be the same number of competitions for gliders as for power aircraft.
5. The competition will be decided at a General Meeting at least fourteen days before the next competition is held.
6. ~~The date and type of each competition must be decided at least one calendar month before the competition.~~ The competitions may be conducted on any day of the month.
7. The points for these competitions will be decided at a general meeting at least two calendar months before the first competition for the year. If this is not decided, then the points system for the previous year will be used.
8. The starting time for each competition will be decided at a general meeting at least one calendar month before the event. If this is not decided, the starting time will be 9:00 am.
9. The results for each competition will be decided on the total points of all rounds flown.
10. The number of rounds for each competition must be decided at a general meeting at least one calendar month before the event. If this is not decided, there will be two rounds for powered events and three rounds for glider events.
11. A competition cannot be cancelled but may be postponed to a date to be decided at a general meeting or on a vote by competitors present on the day. If the Club's Competition Director is also a competitor, he/she cannot vote as a competitor but may cast a deciding vote as Competition Director.
12. A competition may be shortened (number of rounds reduced on the day) only on the unanimous decision of all competitors present. If all competitors have not flown the same number of rounds, then a result will be declared on the average score per round flown.
13. Late entries will be accepted after the nominated starting time but only before existing competitors have completed their first round of flying.
14. These rules may be changed only at an Annual General Meeting or at an extraordinary general meeting convened for that purpose.
